 - _____ At least 36" of 1 1/2 inch exhaust pipe extending from the exhaust manifold.....
 - _____ Stock Ford roller type, New Day, Anderson, flapper type, or crystal timers. No quick couplers.
 - _____ (*)Studs on wishbone at rear of pan safety wired.
 - _____ Must have standard group-one six volt battery.
3.
 - _____ No sagging, re-arching or shortening of springs and at least 7 leafs per spring.....
 - _____ All transmission bands in working order.
 - _____ Body parts stock for year of car.
 - _____ Original turtle deck or substantially built box or turtle deck.....
 - _____ (*)Emergency brake in working order.
 - _____ Model "T" wheels: wire, wooden spoke, disk, 30 x 3 1/2" wire, or Model "A" 21" wire wheels. Must not have cracks or broken spokes(*)
4.
 - _____ Gas tank stock for that year of car and mounted in its stock position.
 - _____ Radiator stock dimensions including tanks and side brackets.....
 - _____ Stock or Ruckstell rear end with Ruckstell locked in high.
 - _____ (*) Windshields have safety glass top and bottom. Windshield must be completely closed and properly sealed.....
 - _____ No auxiliary wheel brakes, such as Rocky Mountain brakes.
5.
 - _____ Carburetor bolts for fastening carburetor to intake manifold drilled through the threaded end.....
 - _____ Stock NH swayback or Ford swayback carburetor including choke butterfly.....
 - _____ The Association's 0.710 inch gauge must not go through this carburetor.
 - _____ Two head bolts, two lower oil pan bolts. Two carburetor bolts, sealed.

* Any items deemed unsatisfactory by the inspectors will be brought to the attention of the directors for resolution prior to endurance run. Inspectors are encouraged to look for any items that are unsafe and report these items to the directors.
